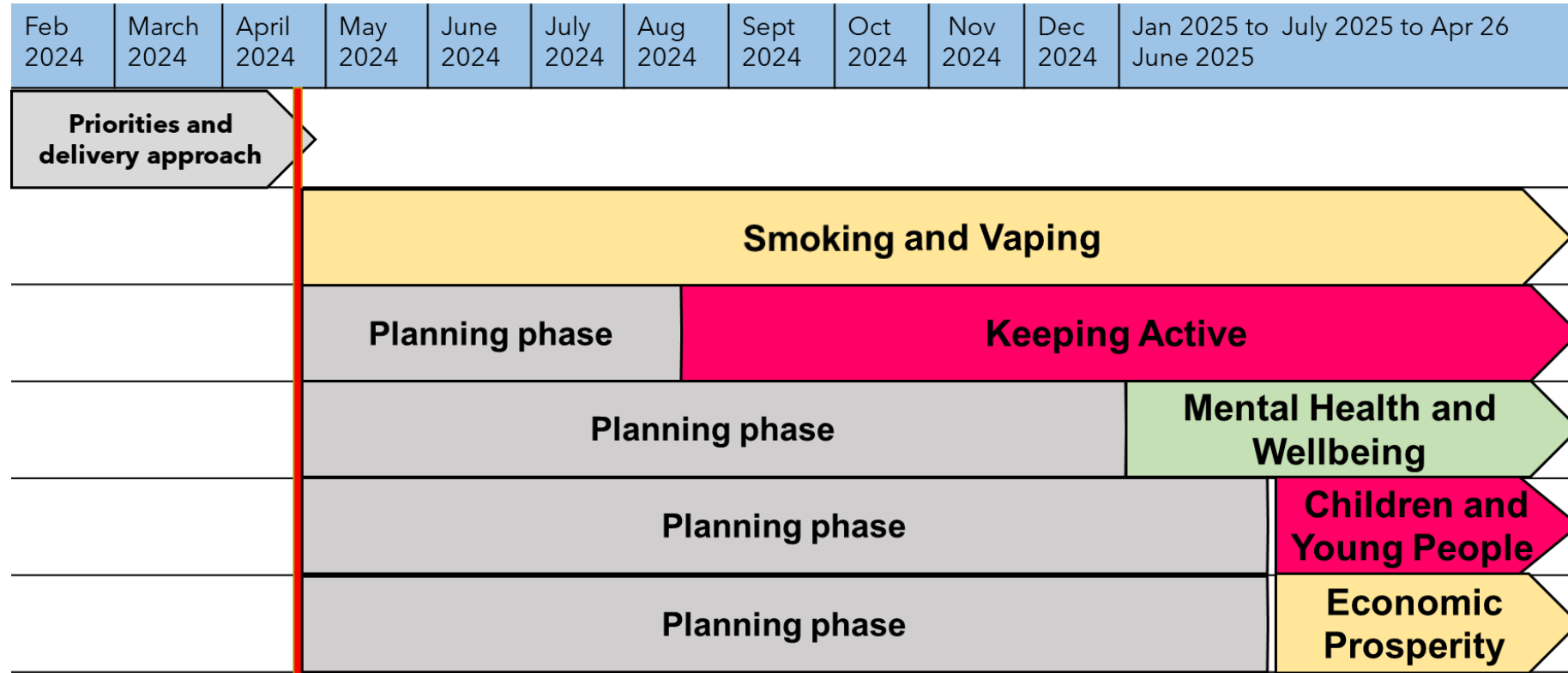

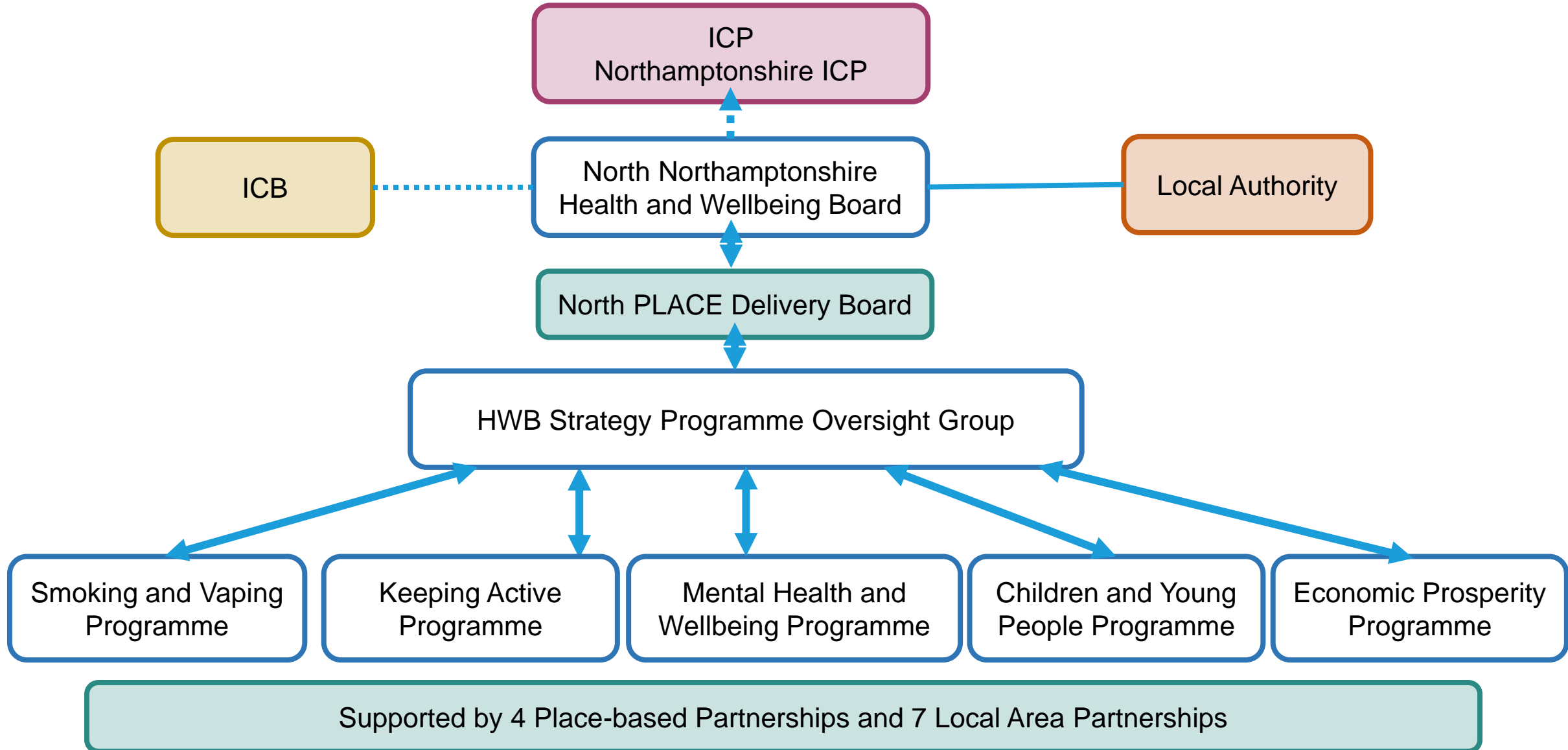

- Aim to present Delivery Plan and progress report at next HWB Strategy Programme Oversight Meeting
- Membership of delivery Group to be decided, and alignment with the system-wide Tobacco Control Alliance

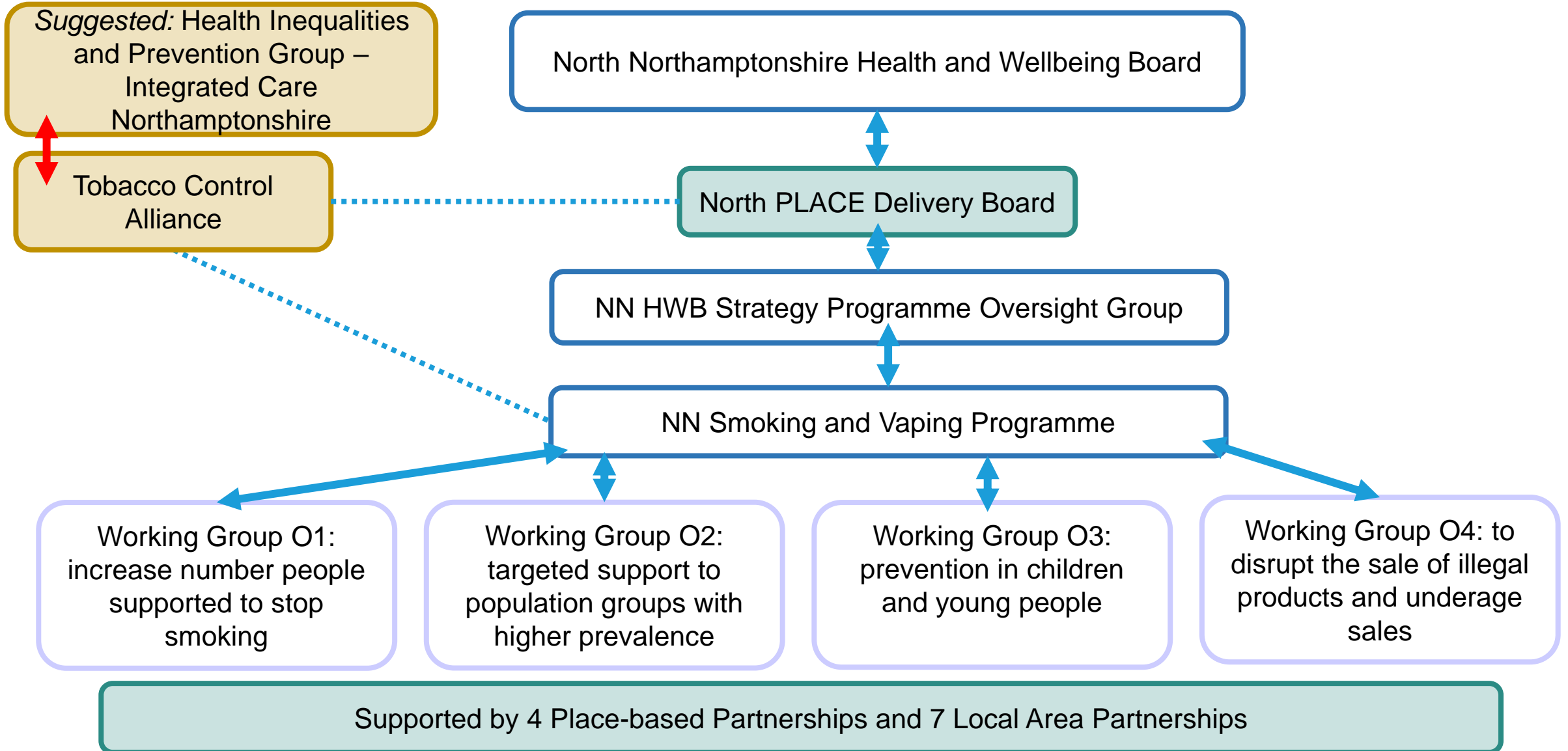
Aim: To reduce the prevalence of smoking, and reduce inequalities in smoking in the North Northamptonshire population

Objectives:

1. To increase the number of residents supported to stop smoking through the Local Authority and NHS services
2. To provide targeted support to population groups with higher prevalence of smoking
3. To implement prevention activities focused on smoking and vaping in children and young people
4. To disrupt the sale of illegal tobacco and vaping (e-cigarettes) products and reduce underage sale



Governance: Smoking and Vaping Programme



Tobacco Control Alliance

The Northamptonshire Tobacco Control Alliance serves as a strategic oversight and advisory group. It aims to foster a collaborative effort to achieve national smoke-free ambitions and improve the health of Northamptonshire communities.

Locally they aim to:

1. Diminish the roles of tobacco and smoking in Northamptonshire, making for safer and healthier communities.
2. Provide a platform for partners to advocate, coordinate and monitor activities that contribute to this agenda.
3. Serve as a forum for information exchange and a voice for tobacco control in Northamptonshire.
4. Act as a collective of key strategic partners, adopting a check and challenge approach to tobacco control activity in Northamptonshire.
